Water Main Break on Beaver St. has been fixed. Due to the location of the leak, Clint Riely to take a look at the bridge at MRR park to look for cracks. Notification will be given to Allegheny County if anything out of the ordinary is found

Josh Lambert discussed editing the new website and who wants the ability to edit the website. Discussed the implementation of emails for the *CouncilMember@glenosborne.org* transition and how that will take place.

Select members of Council will meet at library for a “clean-up session” to hash out the final details on the website.

John Orndorf talked to Brian Brown about Bill Boswell’s driveway. Borough work had been completed at the base of his driveway that caused visual variances to its finish. Brian said it would cost less than \$400 to seal the driveway in an effort to have a uniform finish.

The LSA grant for the rehab of the stone wall on Beaver Rd near Sycamore has been submitted and we will be notified sometime in September if we are approved.

We were rejected to get the gaming grant to replace the manhole installations.

Mayor Doebler raised questions and concerns about the condition of the old Railroad wall along Route 65 at the end of Orchard St. An effort will be made to determine the party responsible for repairs on the wall.

Gary Shurman brought up concerns about property damage done by snow plows to residents’ property.

The “Zach Sparks” bench is to be relocated to MRR park later this spring.

Mayor Doebler – Presented the advantages of moving towards “Live Streaming” and using YouTube® as a repository of Borough Council meetings. He gave overview of the system and how it works as well as his vision of easy access to specific topics. Mayor Doebler is recommending the “Owl Labs, Owl 3” model camera as an economical starting point.
